



WELCOME TO THE ARMY MUSEUM

The Army Museum is composed of two buildings: the Alcazar and the New Building, from which all facilities can be accessed. Externally, both buildings form a single architectural ensemble.

NEW BUILDING: it houses the administrative area, the warehouses, the restoration workshops and some of the public areas such as the reception area, archive, library, auditorium, cafe and permanent and temporary exhibitions.

ALCAZAR BUILDING: it is intended for the Permanent Exhibition and can be visited following three different itineraries:

HISTORICAL TOUR: eight halls where you will be able to know the History of the Spanish Army as an integral part of the History of Spain.

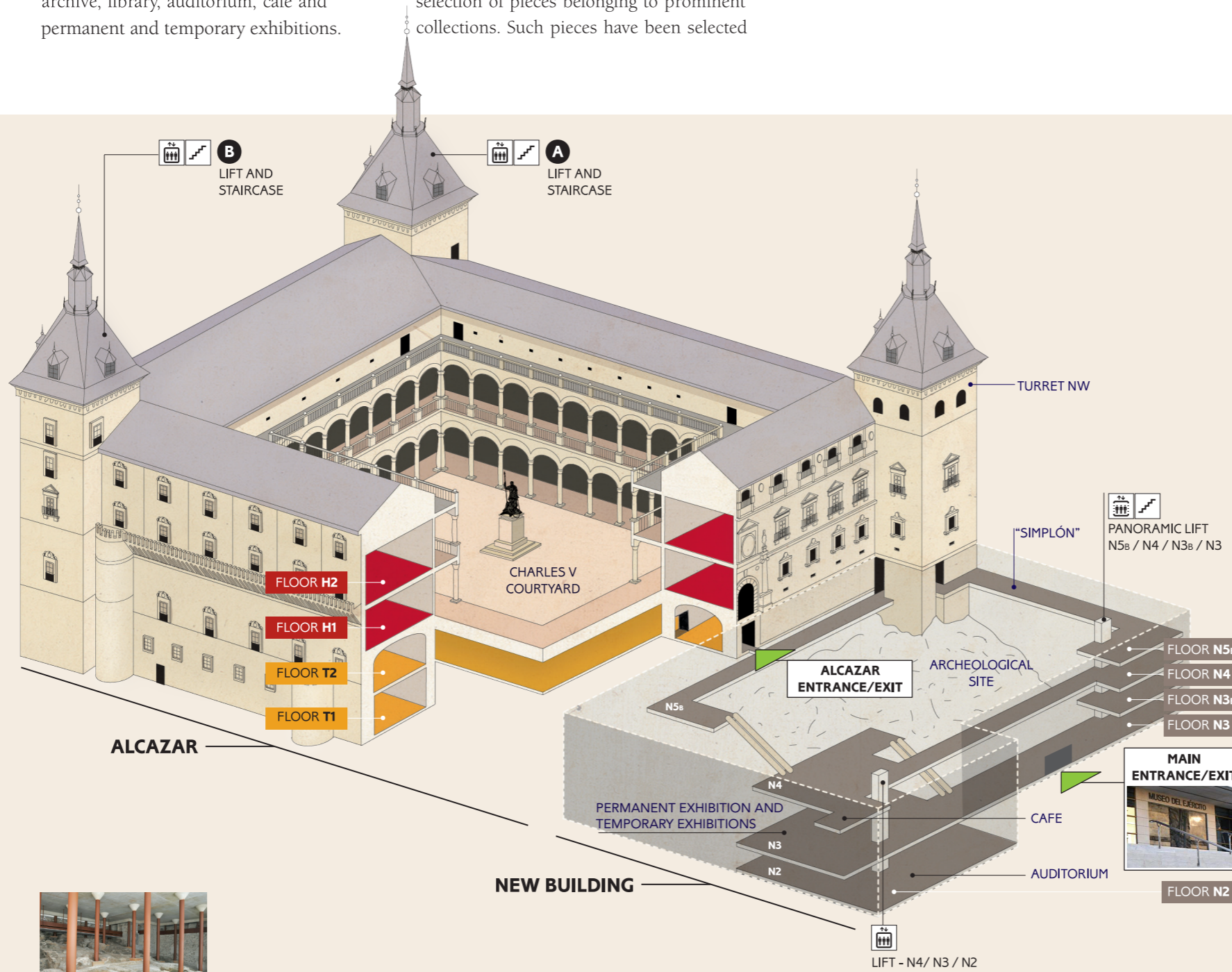
THEMATIC TOUR: thirteen halls that exhibit a selection of pieces belonging to prominent collections. Such pieces have been selected

from among the over thirty-five thousand items kept by the Museum.

ALCAZAR TOUR: unique spaces within the Museum in which History has left a trace that is still visible today.

ARCHEOLOGICAL SITE

The passage from the New Building to the Alcazar goes through the archeological site. In this space you can admire the origins of this defensive spot upheld ever since the Bronze Age, thereby keeping remains from the Roman, Visigoth, Arab and Christian eras. It is one of the largest indoor archeological sites in Spain.

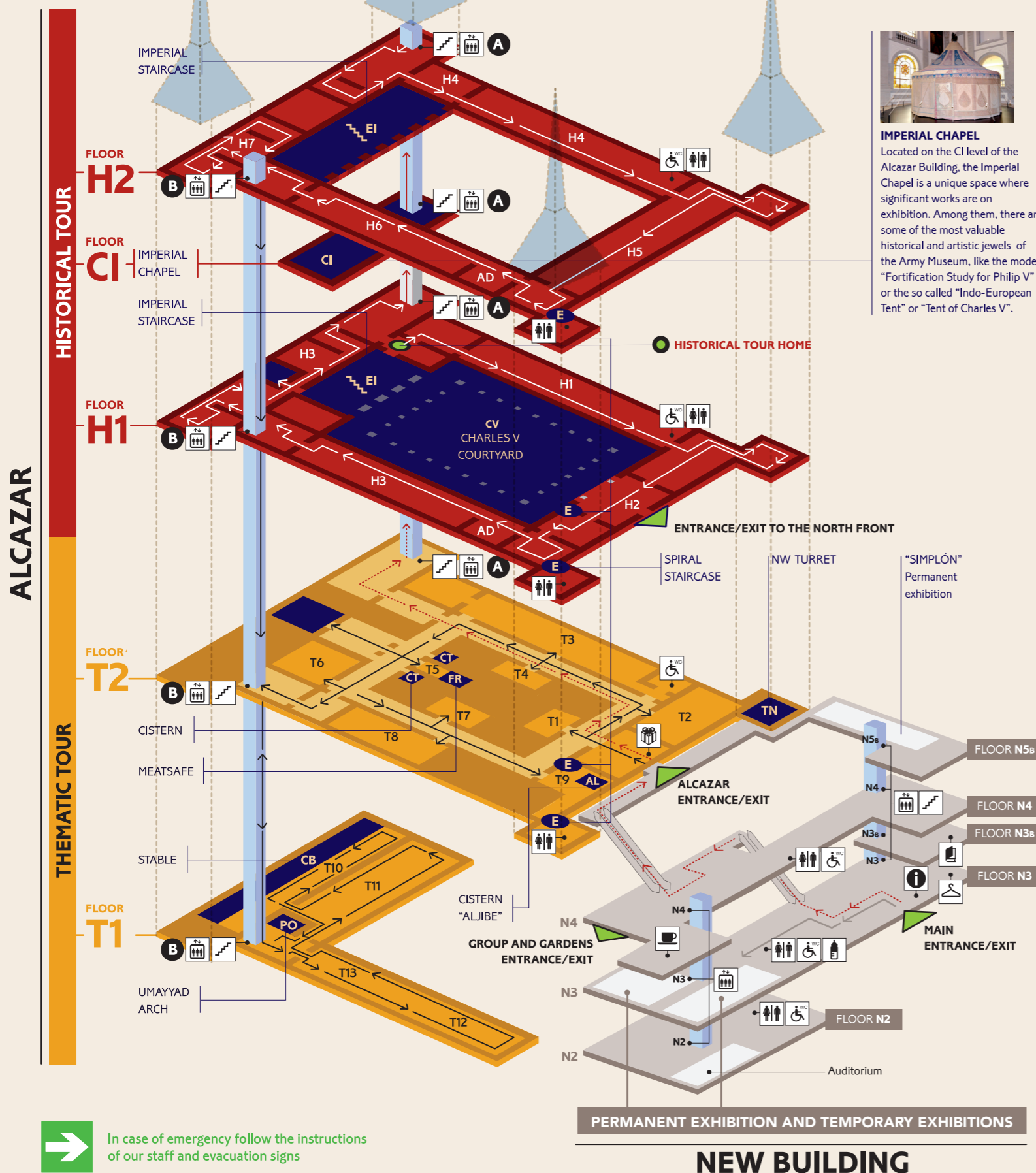
